Ransomware in the Spotlight

Last month, the CEO of the Colonial Pipeline testified in Congress about the company's response to a ransomware attack on their system. Ransomware is a special type of malware that encrypts all the files on your computer and then demands you make a large payment, usually through cryptocurrency, to unlock them. The encrypted files made it impossible for Colonial to run its operations, leading to a gas shortage stretching from Texas, around the gulf coast, and through Pennsylvania.

Hackers have recently deployed ransomware to disrupt companies that provide essential services to the country, but it can also be used to target people individually. With people and companies paying the ransom amounts to regain access to their files, ransomware has become very profitable and very easy to deploy, even by criminals who are not tech-savvy. According to a SonicWall report, ransomware attacks increased by 62% from 2019 to 2020.

While it is growing threat, you can take the following measures so that you can avoid a ransomware attack:

- 1. Like other malware, ransomware can get access to your computer through phishing emails or malicious sites. By not opening suspicious emails, links, or attachments, you can prevent a ransomware attack from happening.
- 2. Regularly backup your computer files to a separate drive offline. In case of a ransomware attack, you can restore your computer files without having to pay the ransom. If the backup is not separate, the ransomware could encrypt it as well.
- 3. Keep your computer up-to-date on security software and OS applications. Ransomware often involves exploiting a vulnerability in your operating system or other application, so patching your computer is essential in preventing these attacks.
- 4. Stay alert on the latest ransomware attacks, such as our Security Center located on our website.
