

Other COVID-19 Scams

Fraudsters continue to search for new ways to exploit other people through the COVID-19 pandemic. The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) has sent out several warnings to be on the lookout for these various scams:

• Vaccine and home test kit offers. They will send emails or texts claiming to have these products available for COVID-19, but there is no proof that these products actually work.

• Avoid robocalls. You may receive calls from a recording trying to sell you insurance, offer work-at-home opportunities, or ask for donations. However, the product, offer, or charity is fraudulent, and the robocalls themselves are likely illegal. Generally, you must agree to receive robocalls from a company after it discloses this fact to you.

 Watch out for fraudulent charities Beware of scammers using various tactics to deceive you into donating towards a fraudulent charity. Their tactics include:

- Overtly pushing you to make a donation
- Using names similar to a legitimate charity
- Refusing to answer how vour donation will be used Claiming your donation
- will be tax-deductible, when it may not be


