
Warning Signs of Romance Scams

Fraudsters continue to exploit people through online dating, using them to transfer stolen money. According to the FTC, some of the most popular lies they use to trick people include: claiming to be sick (or someone close is sick), offering to invest money on your behalf, or talking marriage despite never meeting in person.

Fraudsters can be convincing, so if you're looking for love, watch out for these warning signs:

- Immediate declaration of love from someone you meet online.
- Their online profile on Facebook or dating platform was just created, has little information, or follows other potential partners.
- They cannot meet with you because of work, travel, or distance.
- They transfer money to you and ask you to send it to another person through gift cards or cryptocurrency.

Since these scams evolve over time, stay vigilant; if you're asked to do something unusual or unexplainable, refuse it.
Ultimately, by catching these signs early, you can prevent yourself from becoming a victim of fraud or perpetrating it for someone else.
